Best was 22...Kb8 or even Qb6. **23.f5 gxf5 24.Bxf5 Rhf8 25.Bd3 Be7 26.Bxb5+ Kc8 27.Qe2?!** Superior was 27.Ba6+ picking up a tempo and controlling the c8 square. **27...Kb8 28.g5 hxg5 29.hxg5 Rc8 30.Qd3 Ne4 31.Nxe4 dxe4 32.Qd2 Bxg5 33.Qc2 f5** Black has done a very nice job of seizing the initiative. White should have played 31.Nb1, and would have lost the g pawn anyway. Now things are quite dicey. **34.c4 Rh8 35.Rh1 Qe7 36.a3 Qf6 37.Kb3** Better is Rh2, permitting a check if R×R and protecting the 2nd rank. **37...Rxh1 38.Rxh1 Qxd4** Now the game is even, but Black has all the play and his pawns will convert first! **39.Rd1 Qe5 40.c5 Rd8 41.Rg1 Rd2 42.Qc3 Qf4 43.Qh8+ Rd8 44.Qc3 e3 45.Qg7 e2**

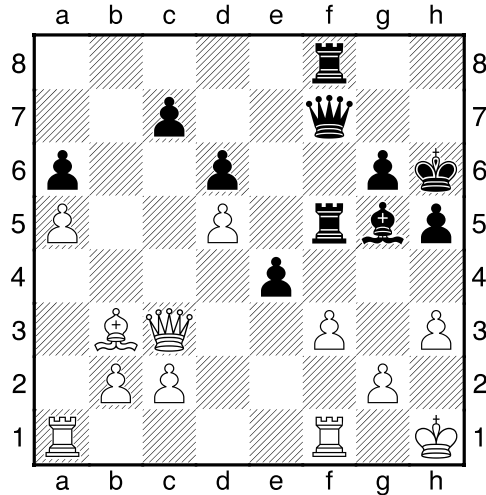


Noel pointed out 46.Ba6! which really complicates things, with both of us in time trouble. Black's best here seems to be 46...Qc3+ 47.Ka4, Bc4! with a sure win. **46.Qc3 Qe3 47.Rxg5 e1Q 48.Qxe3 Qxe3+ 49.Ka4** Before this move I had 6 seconds left and Noel had 9 seconds left, I am not sure exactly the sequence in the ending but Noel lost on time and I had 2 seconds left because he couldnt deliver mate. A great game! **1-0 Time**

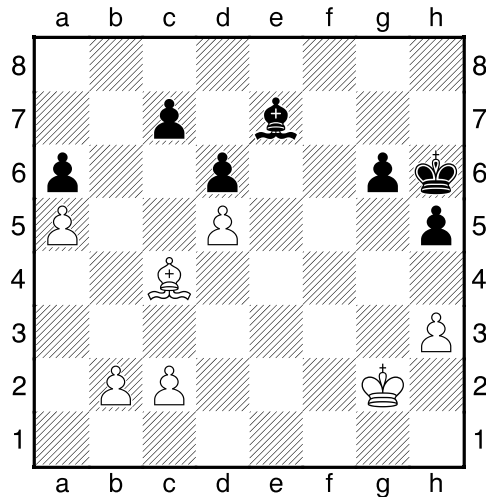
